

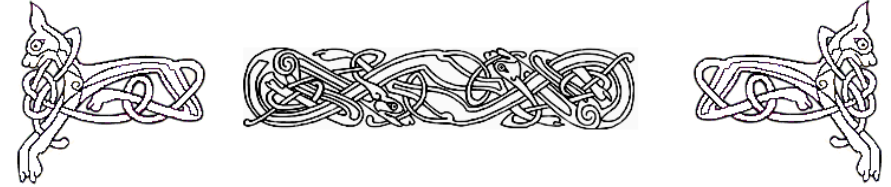

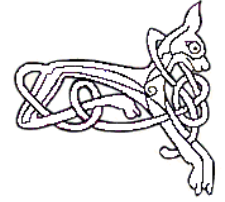
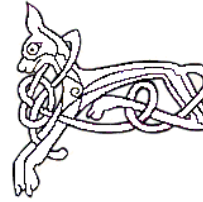

The regular classes will be divided by sex. Neutered dogs and spayed females MAY be entered in all classes. Champions of record cannot enter the regular classes.

Best Puppy and Reserve Best Puppy will be chosen from the first place winners of the 3-6, 6-9 and 9-12 classes.

Best Adult and Reserve Best Adult will be chosen from the first place winners of the 12-15, 15-18, Novice, BBE, Am Bred and Open classes.

Best in Match will be chosen between the Best Puppy and Best Adult.

Non-Regular Classes:

The winners of the non regular classes may not compete for Best in Match.

Parade of Champions- hounds which are conformation champions of record. The Champions will not be judged. There is no entry fee for this class.

Veteran—hounds who are 6 years of age or older. Dogs and bitches will be judged together. Placements will be awarded for 1st through 4th place.

Coursing Champion- for hounds which are ASFA or AKC coursing champions of record. Dogs and bitches will be judged together. Placements will be awarded for 1st through 4th place

Altered— for hounds which are spayed or neutered and not a champion of record. Dogs and Bitches will be judged together. Placements will be awarded for 1st through 4th place.

Best Type-hounds which most exemplify the ideal Irish wolfhound. Dogs and bitches will be judged together. The judge may also request hounds to return for the Type class. Only one hound will be chosen for Best Type. There is no entry fee for this class.

Canine Good Citizen Test

We will hold a demonstration during the lunch break

We will be offering the Canine Good Citizen Test (CGC) following the Match.

The CGC Program was created to encourage people to teach their dogs basic obedience. The test consists of ten parts. Each part is graded as pass or fail. You must pass all ten parts to earn a CGC title. This title can be added to the end of the dogs names just like any other AKC title.

You can read about the test on the AKC web site (www.akc.org) or you can send for a booklet called *Canine Good Citizens Program Participants' Handbook* for one dollar, from the AKC. This book details each part of the test and gives some training tips on how to teach each skill. A good beginner's obedience class will teach you the skills needed to pass this test.

Six things to know before entering the test:

1. You will take the test on a buckle or slip collar.
2. During the test you can talk to your dog and offer praise, but you cannot use food or force the dog to do an exercise, i.e. pushing the dog to a sit.
3. You will bring your own brush for the grooming part of the test.
4. If your dog eliminates at the test area, you will be marked failed
5. If your dog shows any aggression at anytime during the test, you will be dismissed.
6. You can retry at the end of the testing the one part you failed, if this will let you pass the test.

Pre—entry is not required

Entries are limited to 20

Entry for the CGC must include an AKC or LP number
